Materials

- Cross stitch fabric (14-count Aida is recommended for beginners)
- Embroidery floss in various shades of red
- Embroidery needle

- Scissors
- Cross stitch pattern (available for free download at the end of this tutorial)

Instructions

1. ****Prepare your fabric.**** Cut a piece of cross stitch fabric that is at least 6 inches wider and 6 inches taller than the finished size of your design. Center the fabric in your embroidery hoop.
2. ****Separate your floss.**** Separate the embroidery floss into 6 strands. You will use 2 strands of floss for each stitch.
3. ****Start stitching.**** Begin stitching in the center of your fabric. Follow the pattern to create the cross stitches. Each cross stitch is made by stitching two diagonal lines that intersect in the center.
4. ****Continue stitching.**** Continue stitching until you have completed the design. Be sure to keep your stitches even and consistent.
5. ****Finish your project.**** Once you have completed the stitching, remove the fabric from the embroidery hoop. Trim the excess fabric around the edges. Your cross stitch project is now complete!

Tips

- If you are new to cross stitching, it is helpful to practice on a small piece of fabric before starting your project.
- Be patient and take your time. Cross stitching is a relaxing and enjoyable craft, so don't rush the process.

- If you make a mistake, don't worry! Simply remove the stitches and start again.
- Once you have completed your project, you can frame it or use it as a decoration in your home.

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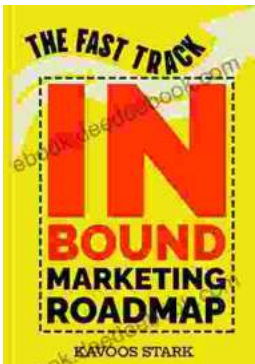
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
