### **Materials:**

- 14-count Aida cloth
- DMC embroidery floss in the following colors:
  - Black
  - Brown
  - Light brown
  - Gray
  - White
- Embroidery needle
- Scissors

### **Instructions:**

1. Start by centering the Aida cloth in the embroidery hoop.
2. Thread the needle with black floss and tie a knot at the end.
3. Begin stitching the outline of the sloth's head and body using a backstitch.
4. Fill in the sloth's head and body using a satin stitch.
5. Stitch the sloth's eyes using a French knot.
6. Stitch the sloth's nose using a backstitch.
7. Stitch the sloth's mouth using a lazy daisy stitch.
8. Stitch the sloth's arms and legs using a backstitch.
9. Stitch the sloth's feet using a satin stitch.
10. Stitch the branch using a backstitch.
11. Stitch the leaves using a satin stitch.
- 12.

Finish by stitching the words "Not Today" above the sloth's head using a backstitch.

### Tips:

\* If you're a beginner, start with a smaller piece of Aida cloth. This will make it easier to complete the pattern. \* Use a sharp needle to prevent the floss from splitting. \* Tie a knot at the end of each thread to prevent it from unraveling. \* Take your time and don't be afraid to make mistakes. Cross stitching is a relaxing hobby, so enjoy the process!
