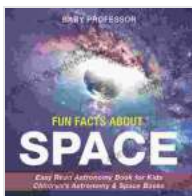

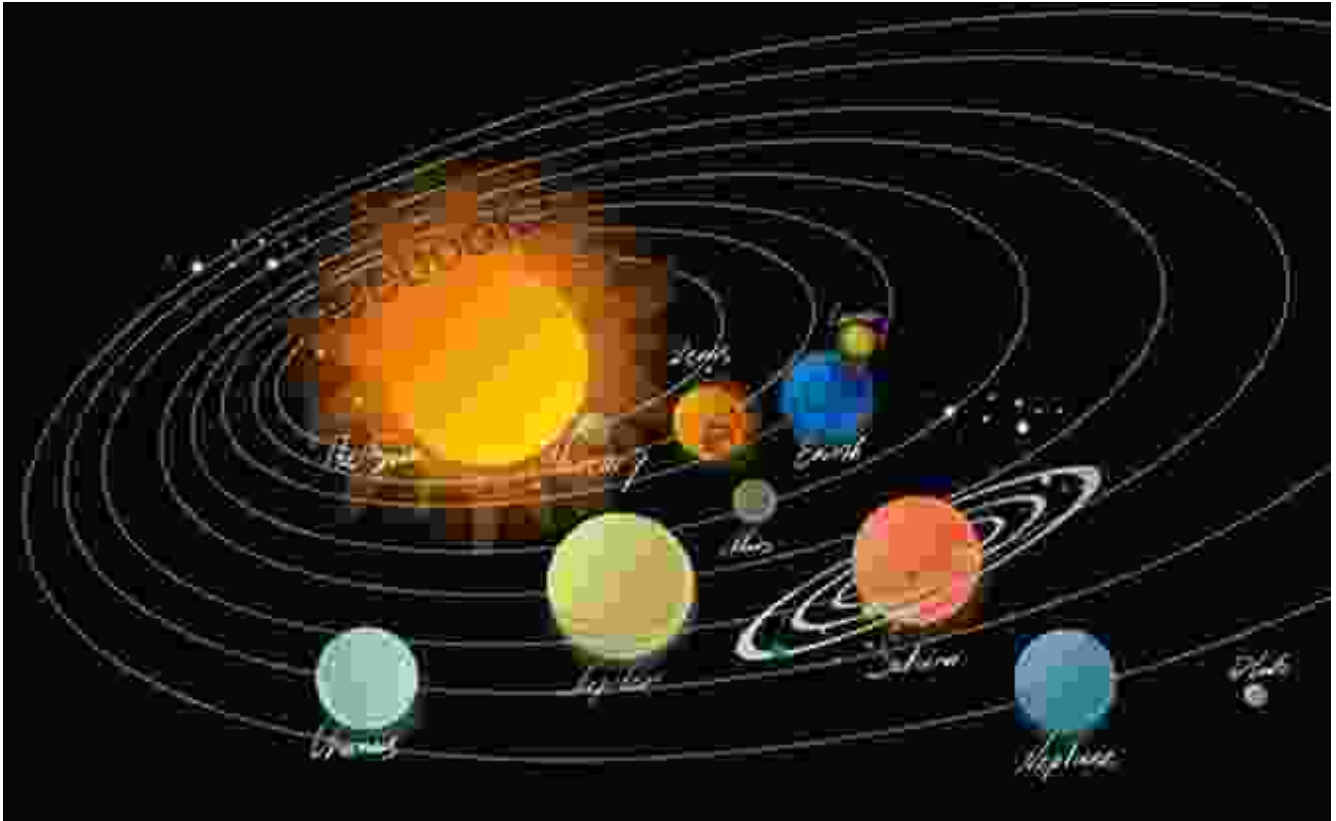

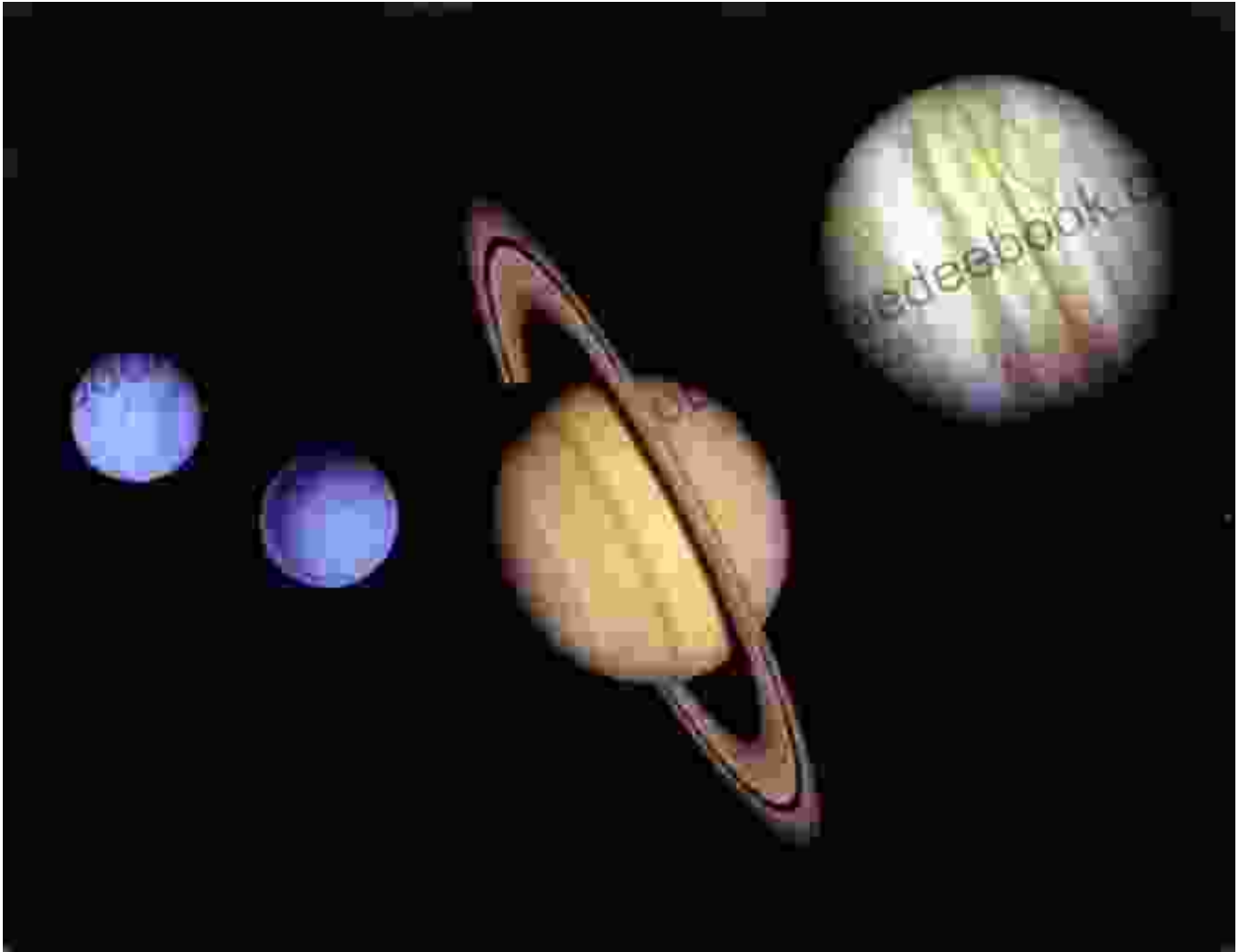
5. Jupiter is the largest planet in our solar system

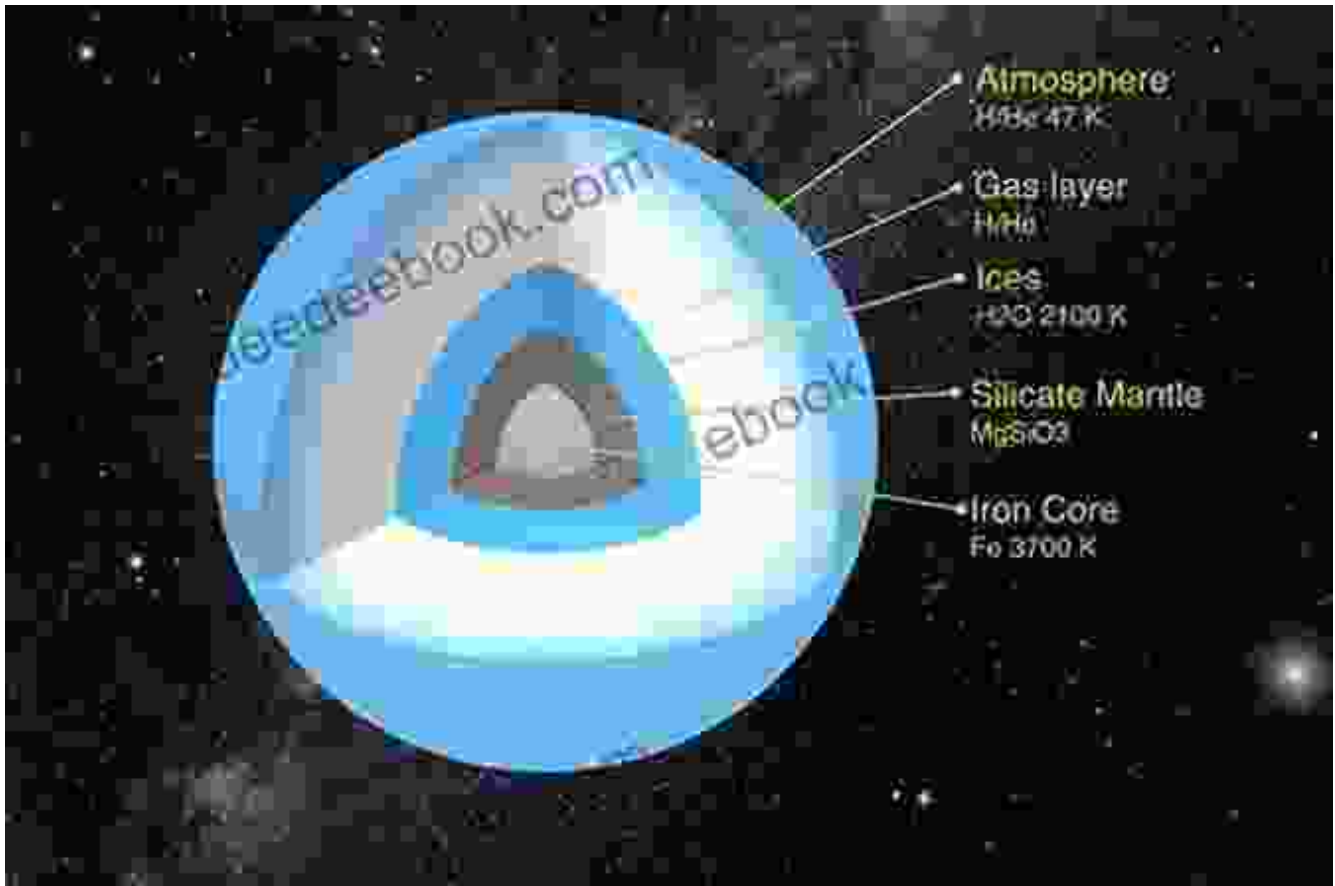
6. Saturn is the second largest planet in our solar system

Saturn is a gas giant planet that is about 9 times bigger than Earth. It is known for its beautiful rings, which are made of ice and dust.



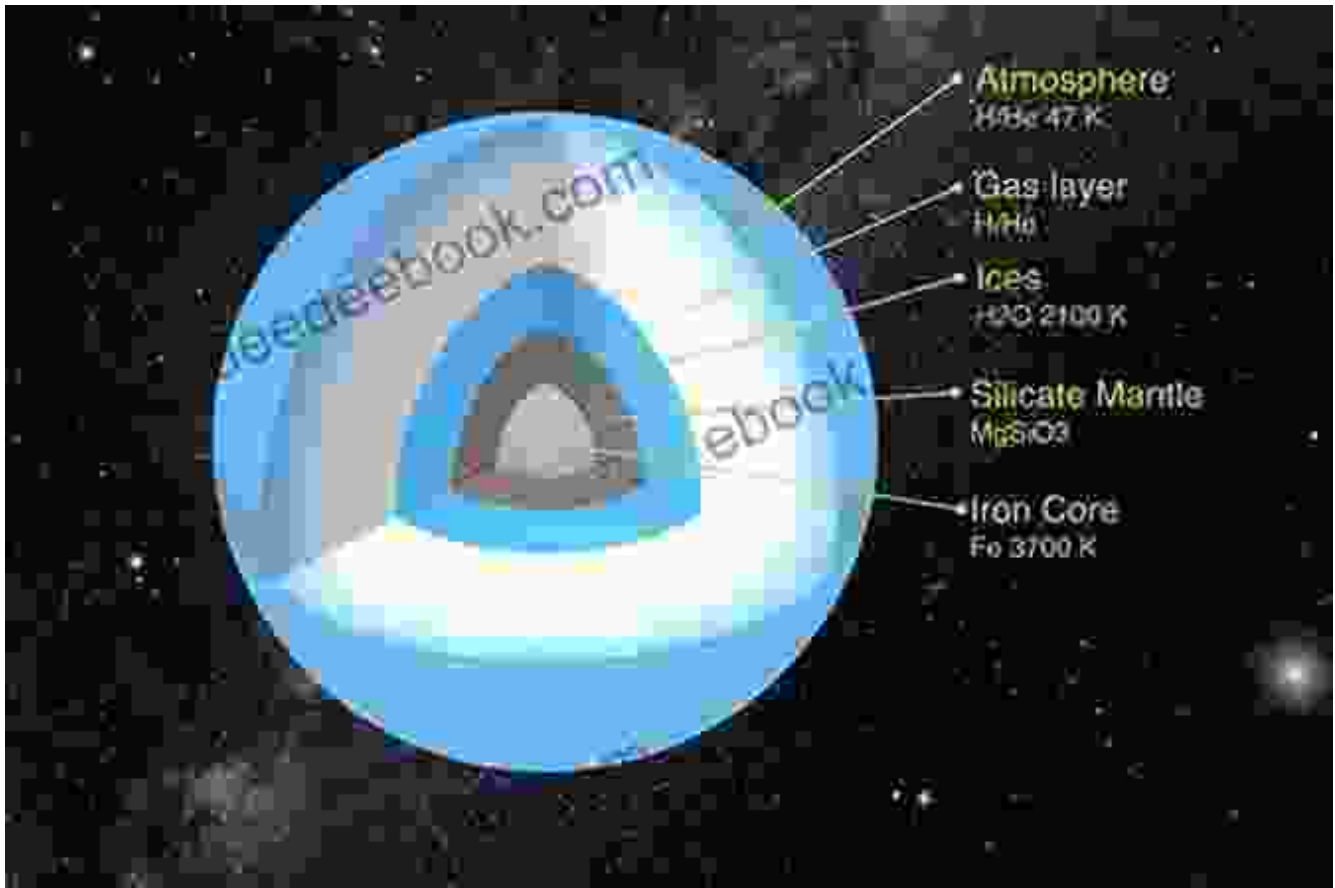
7. Uranus is the seventh planet from the Sun

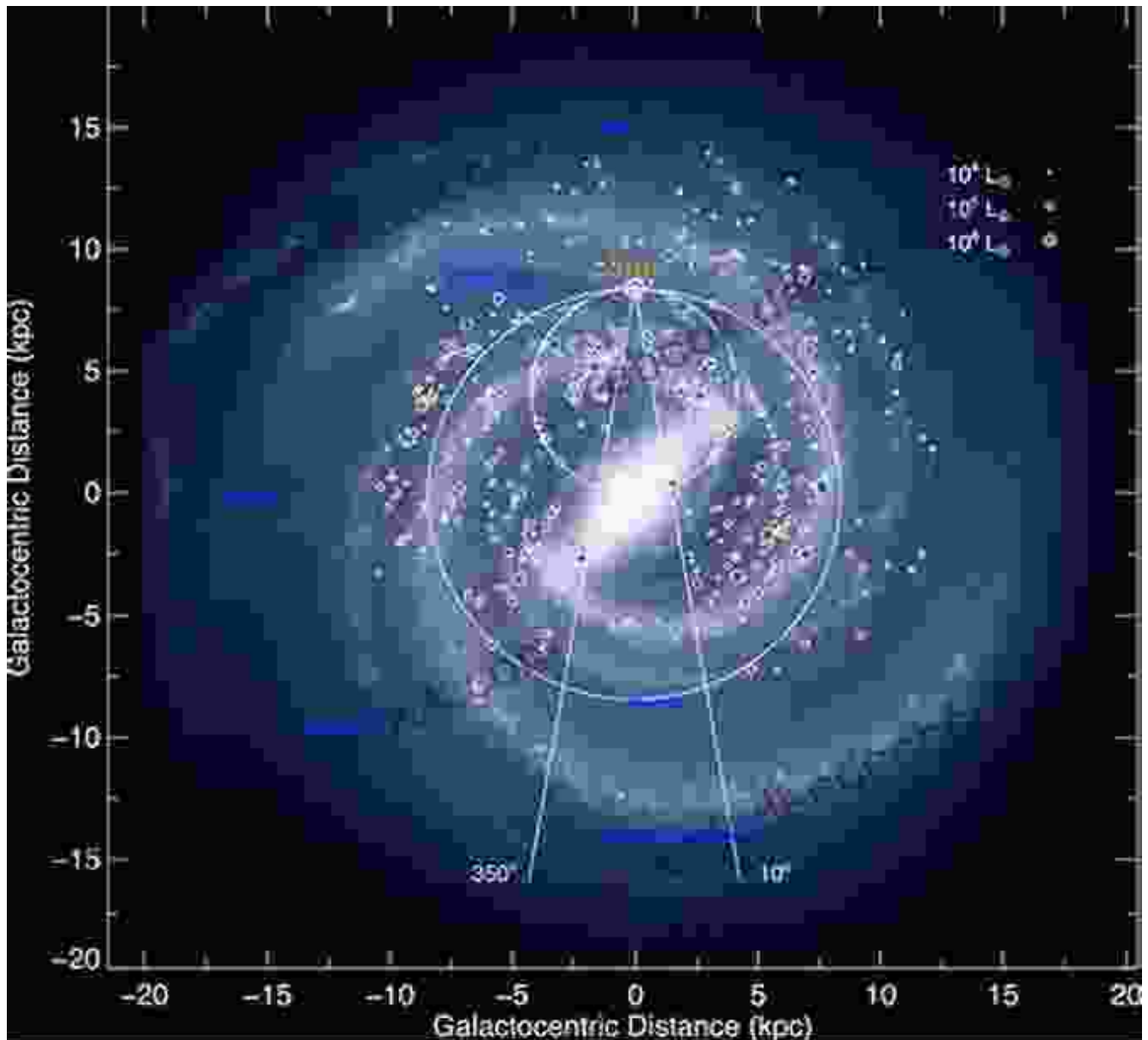
8. Neptune is the eighth planet from the Sun

9. There are millions of stars in the Milky Way galaxy

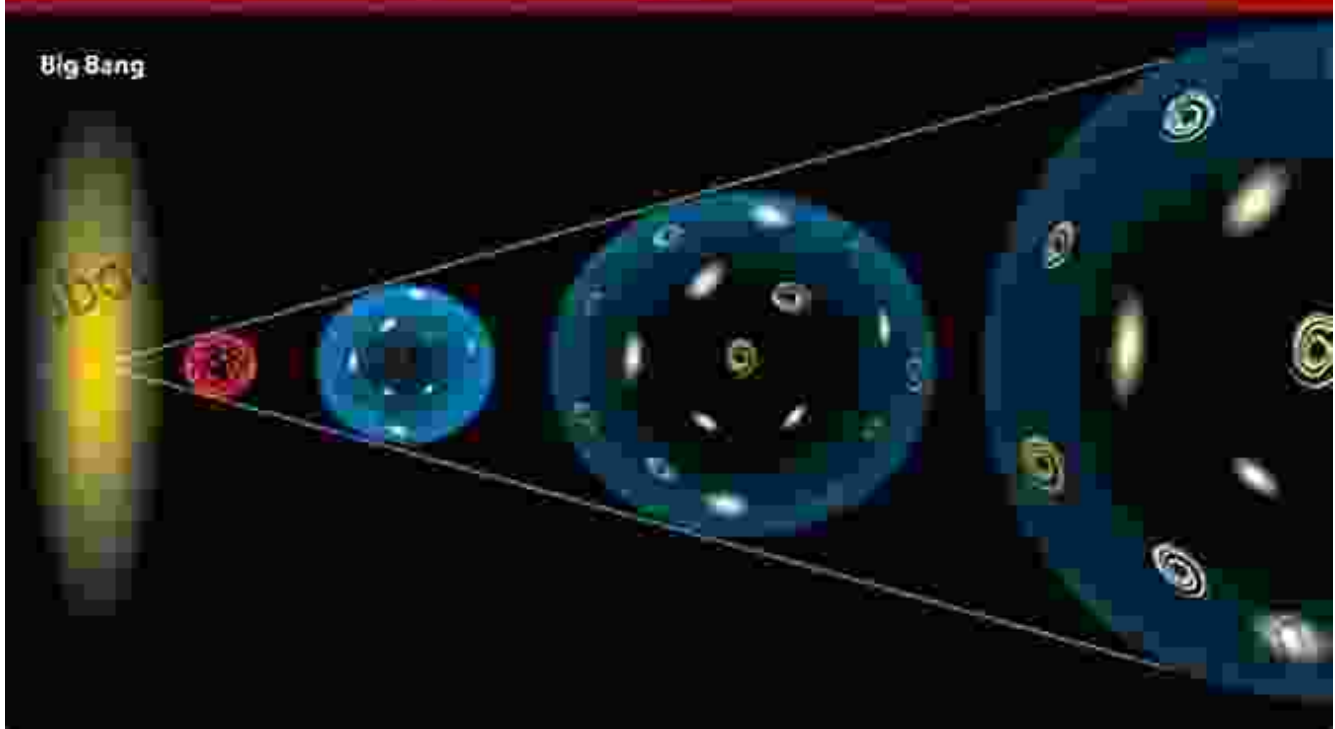
The Milky Way galaxy is a spiral galaxy that contains about 100 billion stars. The Sun is just one of these stars.



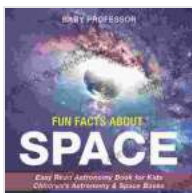
10. The universe is constantly expanding

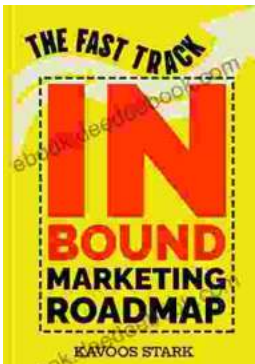
