
# Martin McGuinness: The Man Who Knew



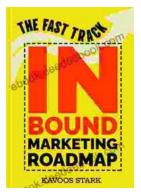
