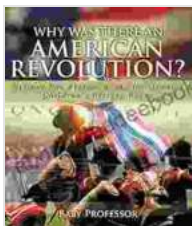

3. The Enlightenment

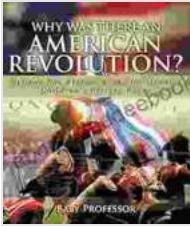

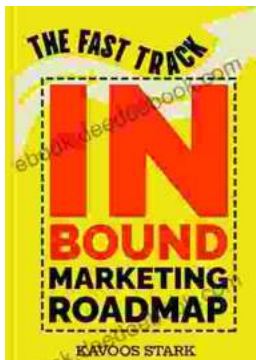
